[Café NONA](#), Národní 1393/4 – coffee/bar located on the first floor of The New Stage of the National Theatre Prague with a beautiful view over the Národní Street, small dishes only

[Rybka Café](#), Opatovická 1315 – tiny and peaceful coffee/bar and bookshop, locals' favourite

[Velryba 24](#), Opatovická 156 – pub (local beer, micro-breweries)
